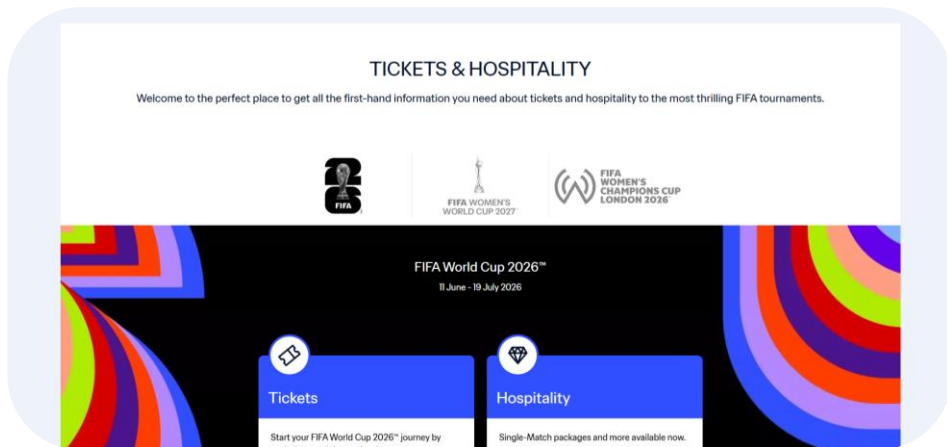
Part 1: Preparing for your Trip

Get your FIFA Pass

Moroccan supporters **residing in Morocco** and planning to attend the FIFA World Cup 2026 matches in the USA shall purchase their tickets so that they can be eligible for the FIFA Priority Appointment System (FIFA Pass) to expedite their interview appointment at the U.S. General Consulate in Casablanca.

- FIFA Pass is not a U.S. Visa category;
- FIFA Pass will only expedite an individual's U.S. Visa interview appointment;
- A FIFA Pass does not necessarily guarantee a visa to enter the USA.

Note: FIFA Pass is operated by the United States government. FIFA does not oversee, nor is it responsible for this initiative.



How to purchase your Ticket?

We advise our Moroccan supporters to purchase valid World Cup 2026 game tickets from FIFA website.

How to Apply for a Nonimmigrant U.S. Visa?

The process goes through the following stages

1

Step 1: Choose type of Visa

As a supporter you should choose Business/Tourist visa, Visa Type: B1/B2

Step 2: Complete the Visa Application (DS-160)

Respect the guidelines for completing the DS-160 Form carefully. All information must be correct and accurate. Please keep the number reference to book your appointment.

Step 3: Pay your visa fees

Visa applicants, including children, are required to pay a non-refundable, non-transferable visa application fee before applying for a non-immigrant visa (B1/B2)

Step 4: Schedule your appointment

Applicants for a U.S. non-immigrant visa should schedule a visa interview appointment at the U.S. General Consulate in Casablanca. Visa application fees are non-refundable and non-transferable.

Step 5: Attend your interview

Moroccan supporters are required to bring all documents listed on their confirmation letter of appointment to the interview. They have also to abide by the security measures as stipulated by the same document.

Step 6: Track your passport

If your visa application is approved, your passport and visa will be sent back to you via a courier service. Once the passport is ready for pickup, you will receive a confirmation via email or text message.

Flights from Morocco to the United States

- **Royal Air Maroc**

Morocco's national airline offers direct flights from Casablanca to U.S. cities, including New York (JFK), Washington, D.C. (IAD), and Miami (MIA). A new nonstop flight between Los Angeles (LAX) and Casablanca is scheduled to begin in June 2026. For further information visit the link below:

- **US direct Airlines**

United Airlines: Provides direct flights from Marrakech to Newark/New York (EWR).

Delta Airlines: provides seasonal direct flights from Marrakech to Atlanta, Georgia.

Accommodation

Moroccan supporters are invited to book their stay ahead of time to lock in better rates. Hotels in the United States require a Debit/Credit card to make a booking. You can also make a reservation through travel agencies or online.



Whether in New York City, Boston, Atlanta, or their suburbs, there are many accommodation options around game venues. Further information is available through the following link:

Airbnb (except the center of New York City) is available in New Jersey, Boston, and Atlanta, as well as other U.S. host cities.

Travel Insurance

You are advised to purchase health insurance before your departure to the U.S., valid for the entire duration of the stay.

Your travel insurance can cover:

- Urgent care and surgeries;
- Accidents and hospitalization;
- Repatriation to Morocco;

Make sure that you keep both a digital and a paper copy of your insurance policy at hand.



Payment methods in the United States

You can exchange money through banks, currency exchange offices, or at the airport. It is not recommended to travel with large sums of cash.

- When visiting the United States from a foreign country, you must be able to prove to a U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) officer that you have sufficient funds to cover your stay in the U.S.
- International travelers entering the United States must declare if they are carrying currency or monetary instruments in a combined amount over \$10,000 on their Customs Declaration Form (CBP Form 6059B).
- International travelers departing from the United States with currency or monetary instruments in a combined amount over \$10,000 are also required to file a FinCEN Form 105 prior to their time of departure.



- **Getting Cash & ATMs**

Money withdrawal from ATMs incurs fees. Those fees are displayed at the ATM before money withdrawal. Check with your bank and credit card companies regarding fees before you travel.

- **Debit / Credit Cards**

Credit cards are widely accepted throughout the U.S. as a method of payment. Depending on your credit card, you might be charged currency conversion and international transaction fees.



Mobile Operators in the United States

Before traveling to the U.S. check with your mobile phone carrier to activate your roaming service in the United States, for calls and data.

Once in the U.S., you can purchase a prepaid U.S. SIM Card at any mobile phone retailer. Your phone should be unlocked to activate a sim / E-sim card. This service is also available online, depending on phone compatibility.

United States Customs (Prohibited and Restricted Items)



Customs and Border Protection prohibits the export of unsafe items at all U.S. ports of entry, including items that threaten health or safety, such as to illegal drugs, counterfeit goods, and certain agricultural products.

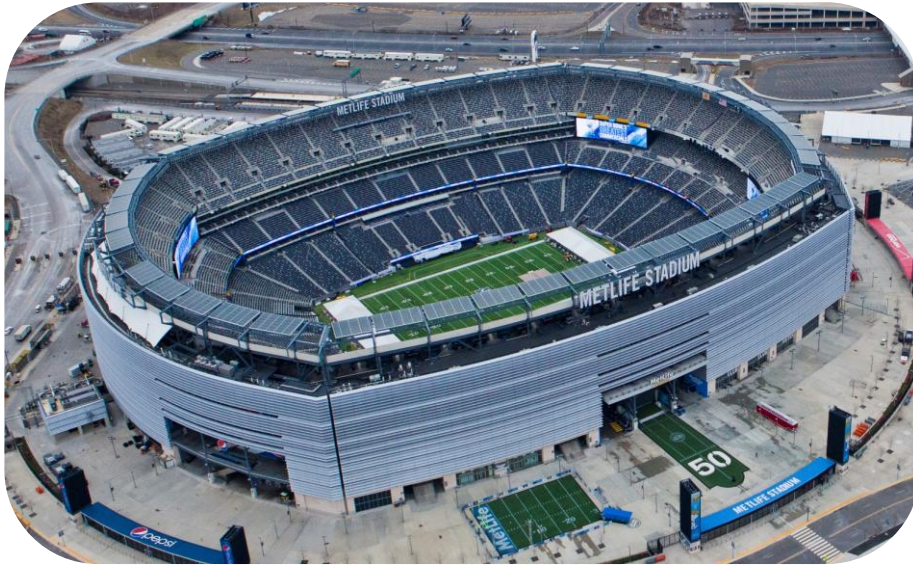

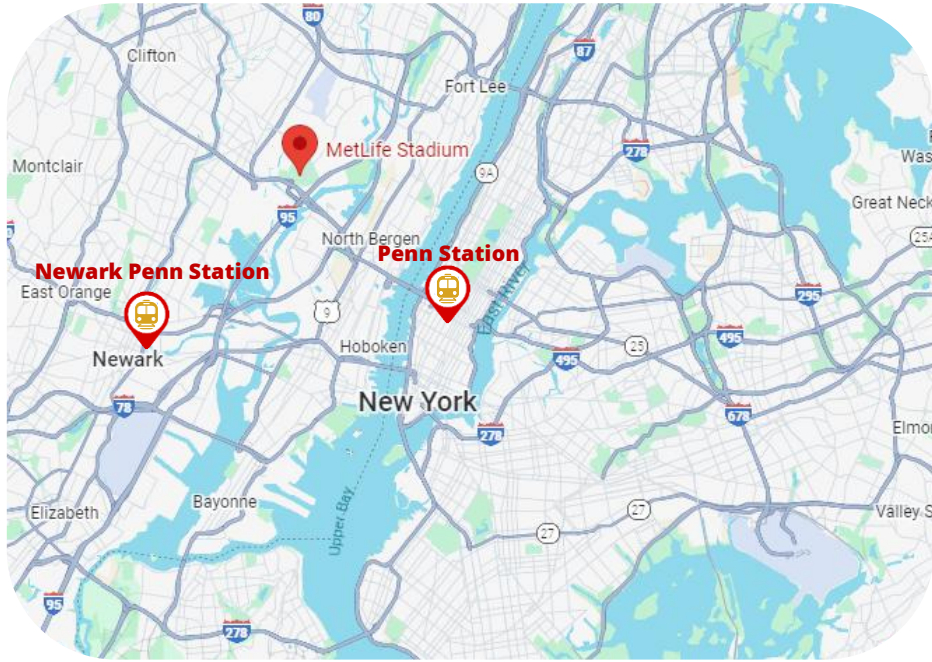
Flights to New York

- Casablanca- New York (Royal Air Maroc) - direct flight
- Marrakech- Newark airport, New York operated by United Airlines.
- Options to travel to New York, transiting via other countries or US cities.

Options for Transfer to Boston

- Bus: New York City to Boston
- Trains: Amtrak
- Flights: Domestic airlines
- Driving: Car rental

Getting to the Stadium

- New Jersey Transit train from Newark Penn Station or New York Penn Station
- Rideshare (Uber/Lyft, etc..)
- Public transportation (metro, bus...)
- Ferries

Intercity Buses

Intercity buses are often the cheapest and simplest option for fans traveling from New Jersey, New York, or neighboring areas.

Gillette Stadium (Foxborough) in Boston

Located approximately 50 km away from the city center

Options for transfer to stadium

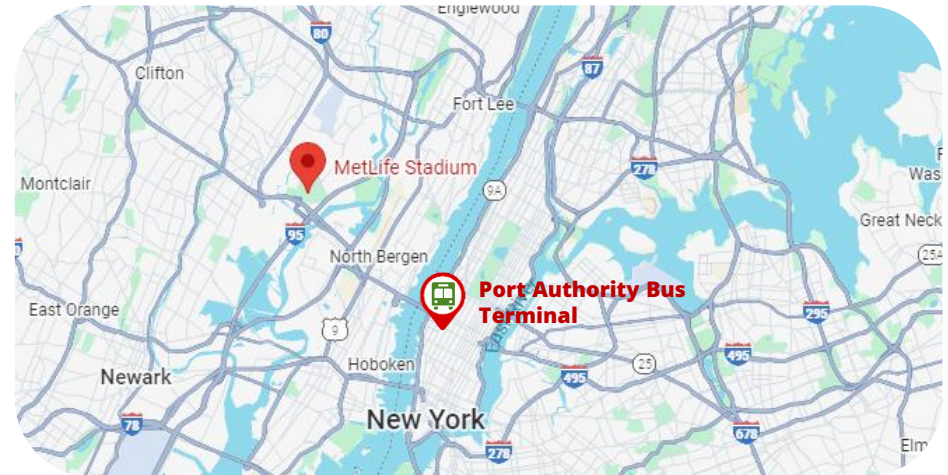
- Rideshare (Uber, Lyft, taxi, etc...)

Boston Logan International Airport: Possible options to travel to Boston, transiting via other countries or US cities.

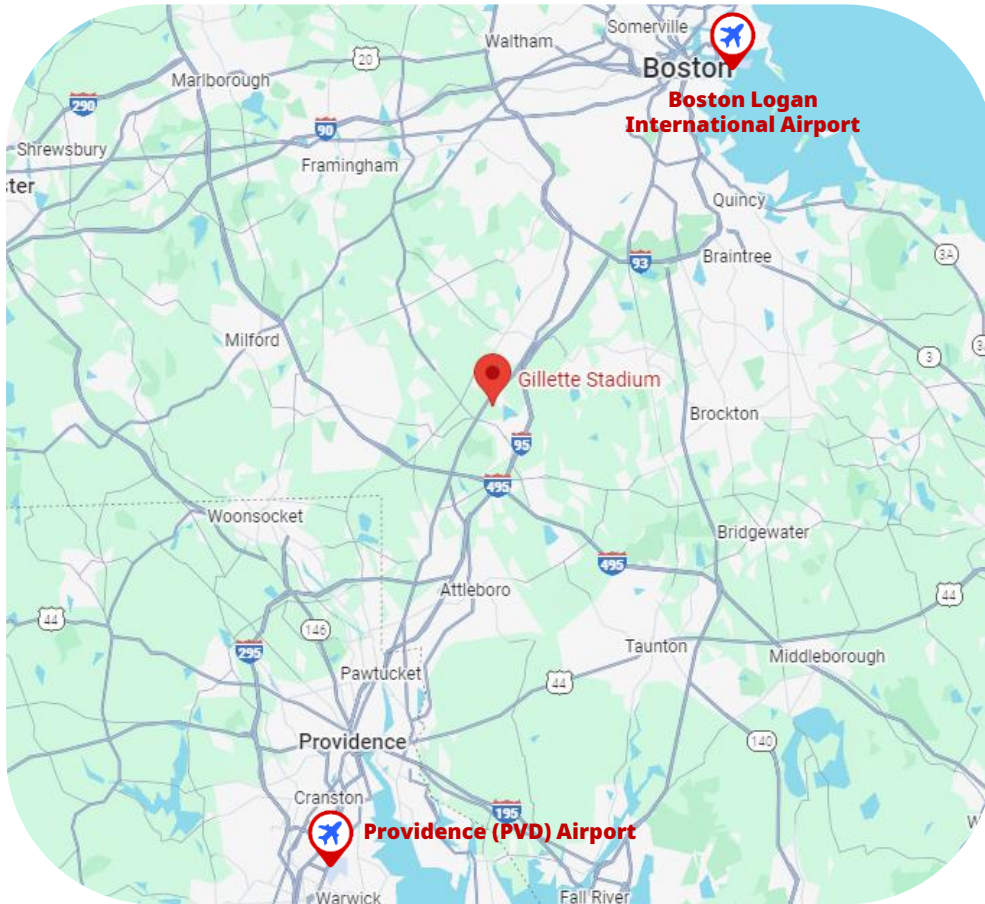
Bus Stations

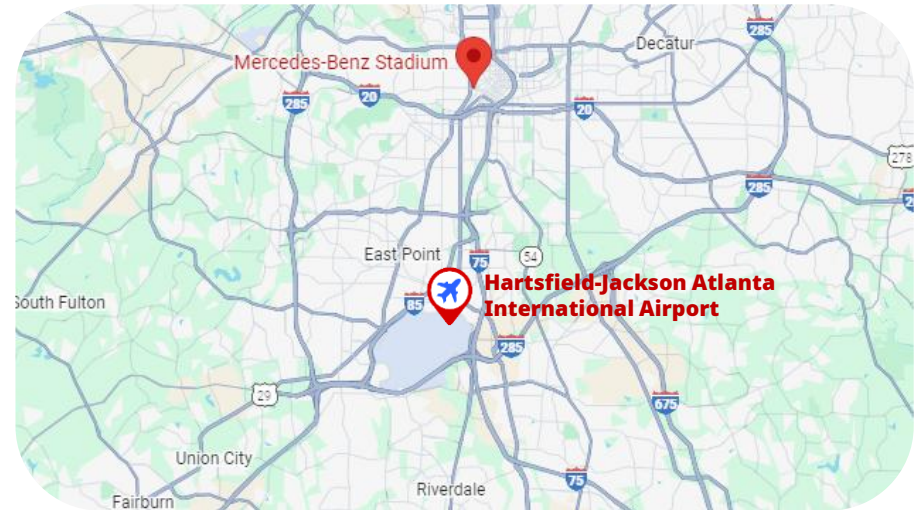

- Direct flight between Marrakech and Atlanta operated by Delta Airlines.
- Possible options to travel to Atlanta, transiting via other countries or US cities.
